

Get to grips with Jersey's Employment Law with new course from | 1

Voisin Law have teamed up with Compass to offer a new course aimed at helping line managers and anyone with people management responsibilities get to grips with recent changes to Jersey's Employment Law.

The course, entitled 'Essential Jersey Employment Law for Managers' is geared for managers across all industry sectors and will help them gain an understanding of local employment legislation and how it impacts them as a people manager.

The workshops will be held from 9am until 12pm on 15th October, 22nd October, 5th November and 12th November at the Compass, 3 Britannia Place, Bath Street, St Helier.
